

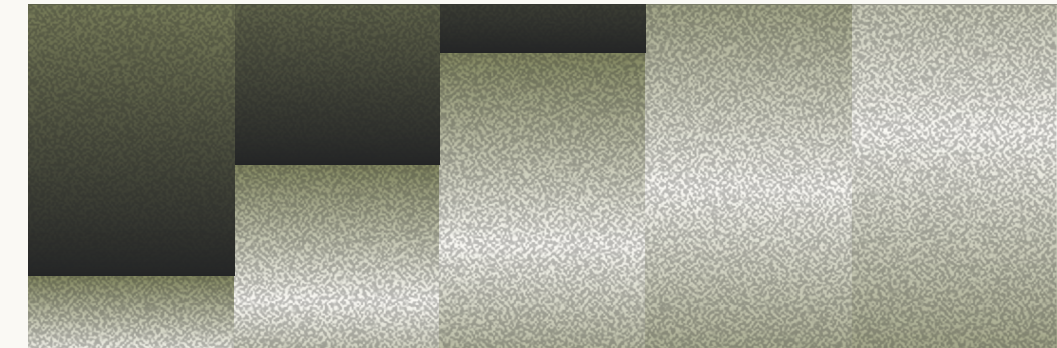
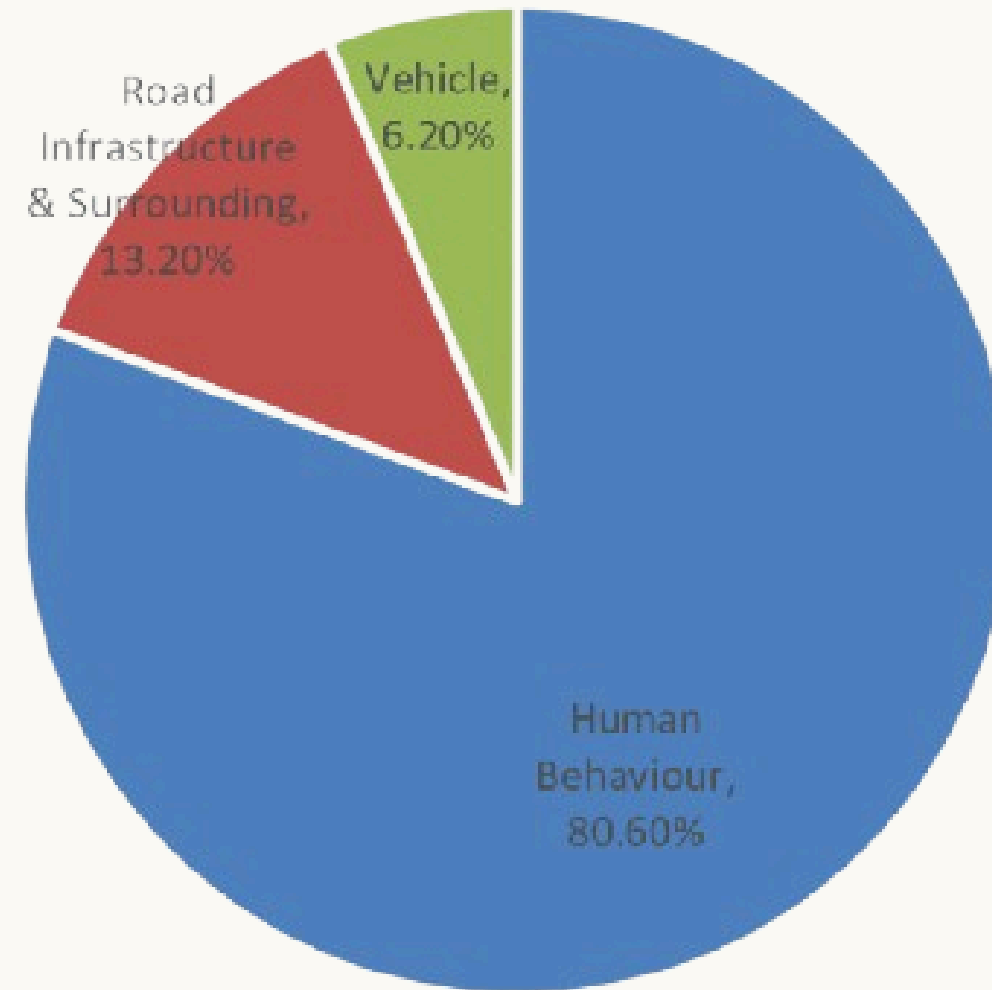
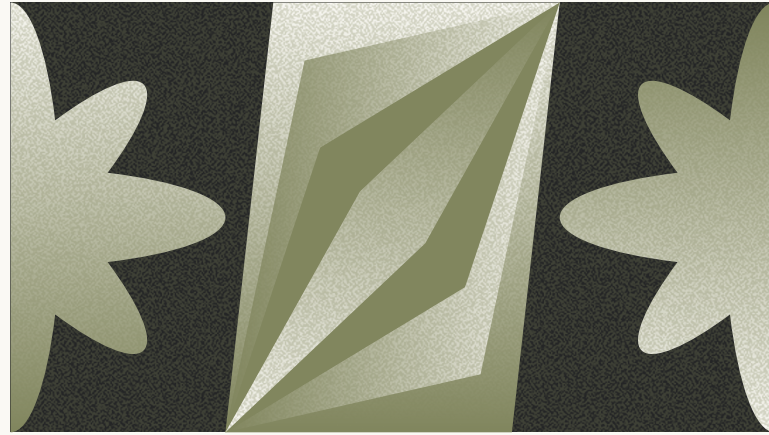

Why Road Safety Matters During Raya



→ Festive Traffic Surge

- Increased vehicle volume on highways.

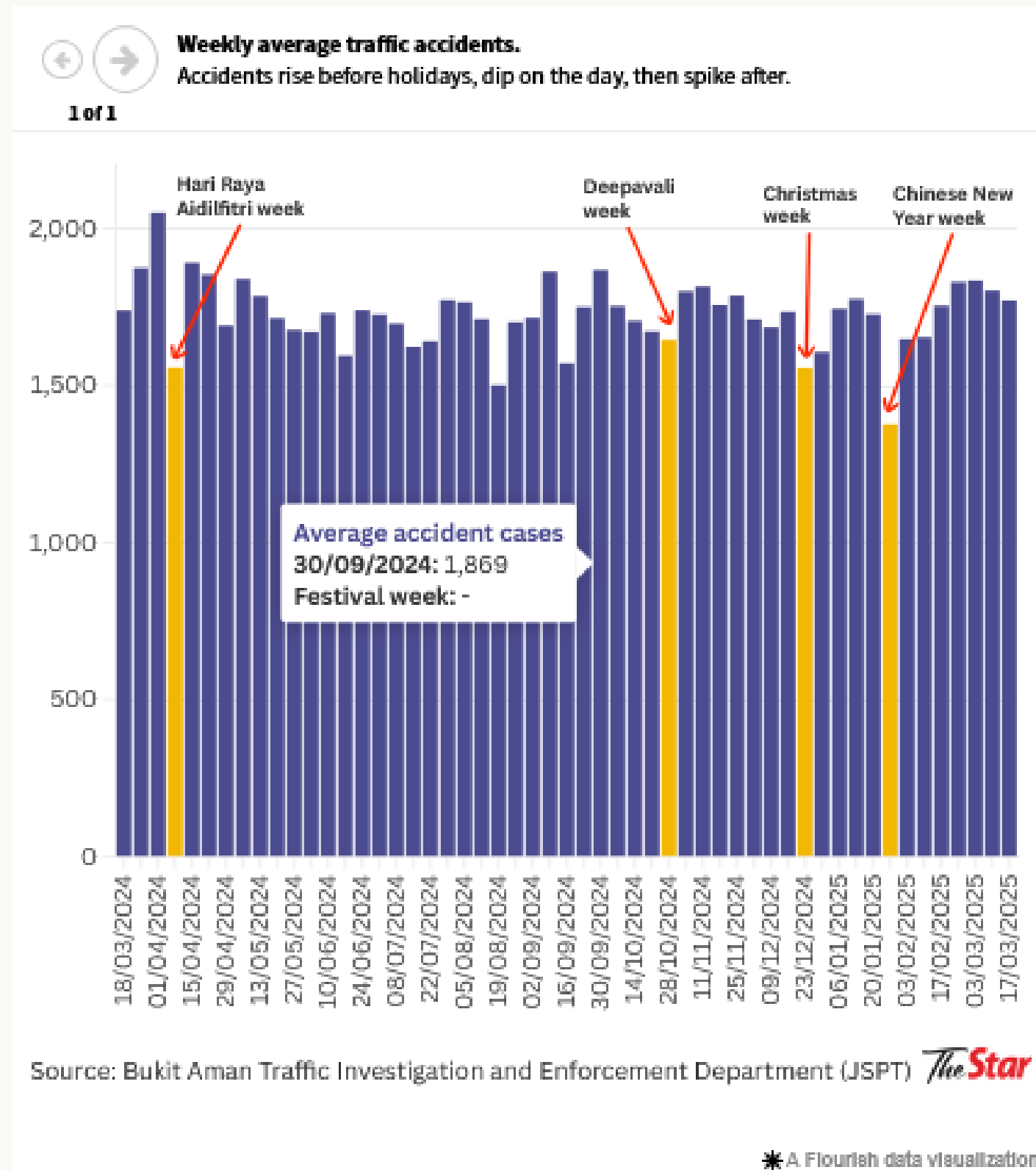
→ Risks

- Fatigue
- Speeding
- Distractions lead to higher accident rates.

→ Goal

- Ensure all employees and their families arrive safely to celebrate.

Accident Graph



➔ Festive Traffic Surge

- Someone loses their life in a Malaysian road accident every 1hr 56 mins
- A road accident occurs approximately every 50 seconds.

In 2024, the three days with the highest number of accidents all fell within the week before Hari Raya Aidilfitri – April 5 (2,185 cases), April 4 (2,160 cases) and April 6 (2,156 cases).

Challenges During Balik Kampung

➔ Long-Distance Travel

- Fatigue and drowsy driving.

➔ Heavy Traffic

- Increased risk of collisions.

➔ Weather Conditions

- Rain or poor visibility.

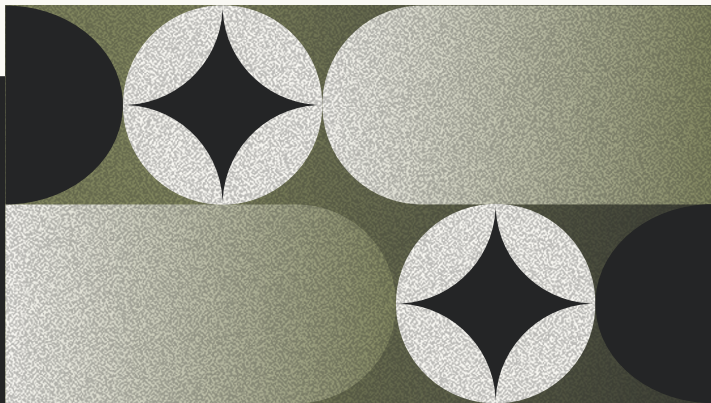

Our Commitment to Road Safety



1. Engine and Fluids

Engine oil: Check levels and top up if necessary.

Coolant: Ensure the coolant level is adequate.

Brake fluid: Check and top up if needed.

Windshield washer fluid: Fill up for clear visibility.

2. Tires

Tire pressure: Check and inflate to the recommended level (refer to the car manual).

Tire condition: Look for cracks, bulges, or uneven wear.

Spare tire: Ensure it's in good condition and properly inflated.

Tire tools: Check if the jack and tire iron are in the car.

3. Lights

Headlights: Test high and low beams.

Brake lights: Ensure they are working.

Turn signals: Check front and rear indicators.

Hazard lights: Test to ensure they function.

4. Brakes

Brake performance: Test for responsiveness.

Brake pads: Check for wear and tear.

5. Battery

Battery terminals: Ensure they are clean and corrosion-free.

Battery charge: Check if the battery is fully charged.

6. Wipers and Windows

Windshield wipers: Check for wear and replace if necessary.

Wiper fluid: Top up the reservoir.

Windows and mirrors: Ensure they are clean and unobstructed.

7. Emergency Kit

First aid kit: Ensure it's fully stocked.

Flashlight: Check batteries and functionality.

Jumper cables: Ensure they are in the car.

Basic tools: Include a screwdriver, pliers, and wrench.

Reflective vest and triangle: For emergencies on the road.

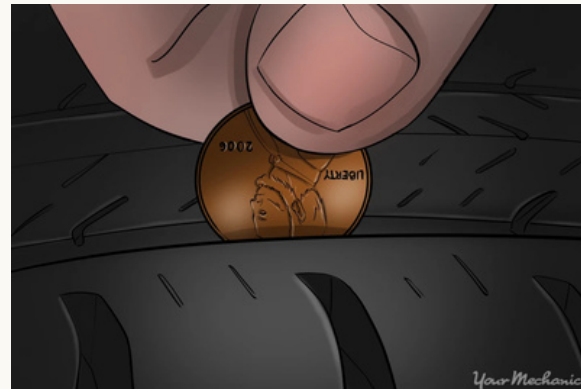

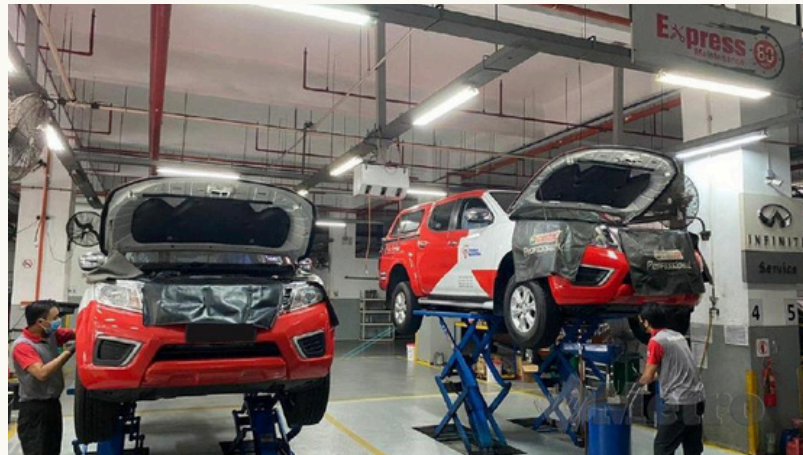
Tips for a Safe Journey

Take breaks every 2 hours.



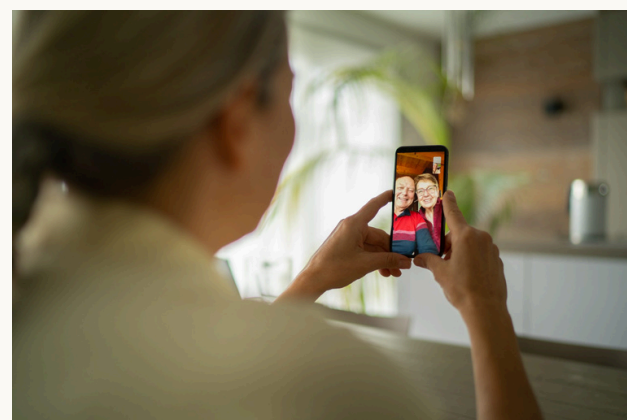
